

### **A grant from the CPMT facilitates your access to the CPA Montréal's training programs**

During fall 2014 and winter 2015, many courses will be offered to you at a subsidized price through the Parity Committee of the automotive services industry in the Montréal region (CPA Montréal). It is indeed with much pride that the CPA Montréal announces you that it has recently obtained a major grant from the Workforce Skills Development and Recognition Fund of the Commission des partenaires du marché du travail (CPMT).

With this grant, we estimate that over 660 workers will be able to benefit from financial support for training. As a matter of fact, there are more than 55 training sessions that are targeted by the grant, including the preparatory to the exam courses and the continuous learning courses in automobile mechanics, truck mechanics and bodywork.

On the one hand, they enable the industry's apprentices to expand their knowledge and in this way facilitate their success in the exam that will make them journeymen.
