

Grant from the CPMT

Employers: the CPA Montréal relies on your cooperation!

The Parity committee of the automotive services industry in the Montréal region (CPA Montréal) has recently obtained a major grant from the Workforce Skills Development and Recognition Fund of the Commission des partenaires du marché du travail (CPMT). This means that many of the industry's workers will benefit from financial support for training during fall 2014 and winter 2015. However, to comply with the CPMT's terms, the CPA Montréal must seek your cooperation.

Crucial information

Being the administrator of the grant and as Emploi-Québec's partner, the CPMT requires that the CPA Montréal provides the name, the Quebec Enterprise Number (NEQ) and the total payroll for 2014 of the employers. The CPA Montréal therefore needs to get this information from you. This is a mandatory condition for receiving funding. Without this information, it will be impossible for the CPA Montréal to provide workers the training courses at the subsidized price to which they are entitled.
